The house, which is located in the Bird Streets, features an open-plan layout and an airy kitchen that Brown kept light and bright with glossy contemporary Bulthaup cabinetry. The space is also warm, thanks to specially milled wide-plank oak floors and an ipe wall over the bar area. Vintage glass pieces continue the earthy tones. "The goal was for the home to feel spacious but not vast," adds the designer, who has offices in Los Angeles and Santa Barbara. But it wouldn't be Hollywood without a touch of sparkle, and Brown added just the right amount with a cluster of vintage glass pendant lamps from Blackman Cruz.
